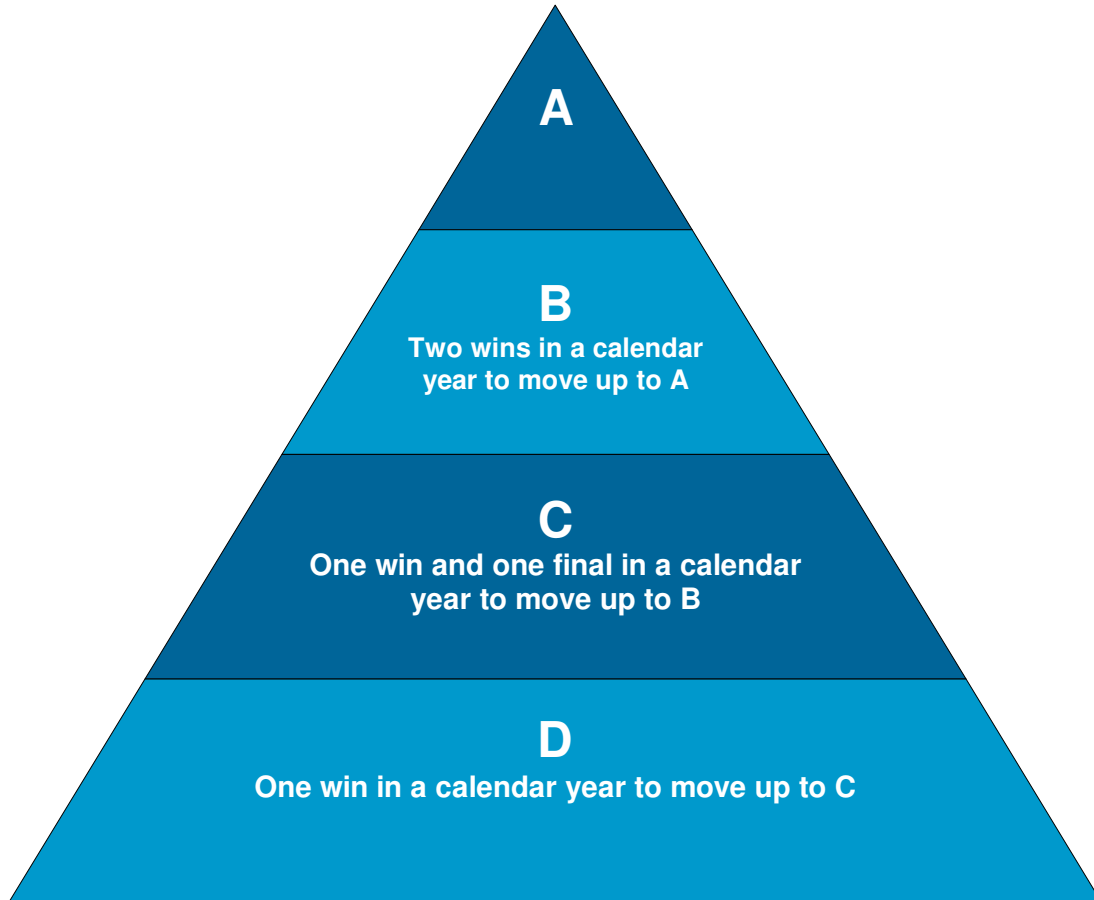




Men's Divisional Diagram



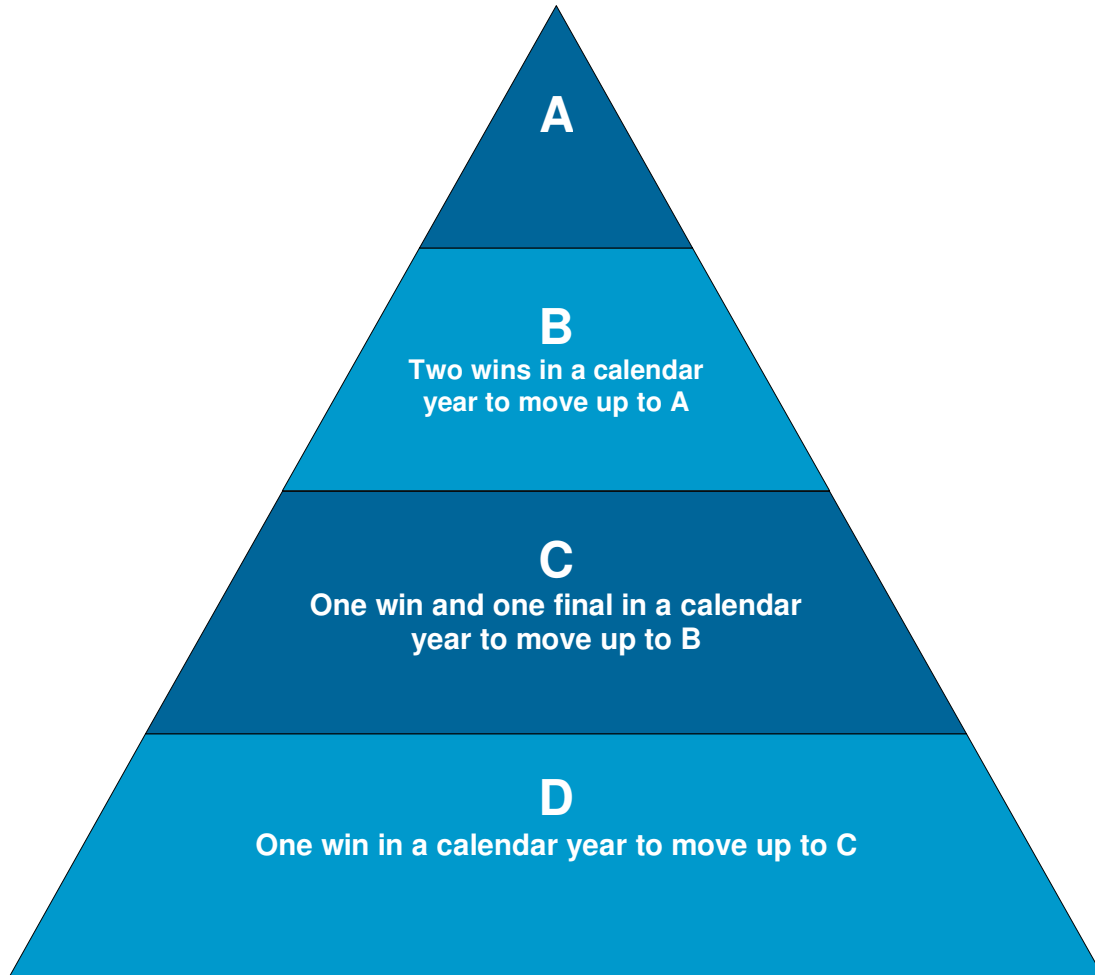
Key points:

- **It is strongly recommended that everyone begins at the D division because once you start at a division you may not go to a lower division**
- **Minimum draw of 8 is required**
- **A player cannot move up to the A division winning the same tournament twice in a calendar year unless it is one of the bigger provincial tournaments**
- **A calendar year is considered 12 months from the day you won a tournament**

Key points:

- It is strongly recommended that everyone begins at the D division because once you start at a division you may not go to a lower division
- Minimum draw of 8 is required to make the transition official. If registration is low, and you consistently win round-robin draws, you can move up a level. Once you move up, you cannot move back down.
- A player cannot move up to the A division winning the same tournament twice in a calendar year unless it is one of the bigger provincial tournaments.
- A calendar year is considered 12 months from the day you won a tournament
